Port of Argentia is seeking nominations to fill vacancies on its Board of Directors.

Port of Argentia is incorporated as a not for profit organization with a mandate to provide effective stewardship of Argentia for the long-term benefit of the communities and people of the Placentia region. Port of Argentia owns and manages the Argentia Marine Terminal (Fleet Dock) and 9,000 acres of upland property formerly comprising the US Naval Base at Argentia.

Port of Argentia has an nine (9) member voluntary Board of Directors which meets with the Management Team generally monthly or as frequent as necessary to effectively and efficiently guide the organization toward achieving its mission.

The Selection Committee is seeking Candidates whose skills, knowledge and experience meet the needs of the Board and strengthen the Board's work team. The selection process will take place as follows:

- < Each Candidate will have his/her principal place of residence within the Port's mandate area - Ship Harbour, Fox Harbour, Point Verde and Placentia.**
- < An individual who has completed a term of service on the Board is eligible to reapply as a Candidate.**
- < Each Candidate will to be nominated by two (2) residents in the Port's mandate area.**
- < Each Nomination will submit a resume or completed application.**
- < Nominations will be accepted at the address below up to 12:00 noon on March 31, 2023.**
- < Candidates will be selected for service based on his/her skills, knowledge and experience relevant to the Port mandate.**

Port of Argentinia Profile



Port of Argentinia is a premier heavy industrial seaport offering ice-free, year-round access, a wide turning basin, heavy lift capacity, with up to 11-metre draught alongside 645 metres of dock facilities.

The Port features a variety of stevedoring, transportation, heavy lift cranes, and other dock services available on site in support of both domestic and international container shipping. The Port is certified by Transport Canada as compliant under the Marine Transportation Security Regulations (MTSR), with dock facilities surrounded by a 40-hectare secure fenced compound.

Over 30 businesses, port users and tenants provide support services to port operations and industrial projects. Port of Argentinia is the host site of Cenovus Energy's Concrete Gravity Structure construction in a purpose-built graving dock. Once completed, the wellhead platform will be installed offshore in support of the West White Rose Project.

The Port owns and operates the Argentinia Marine Terminal, Northside Industrial area, Southside Industrial Park and Argentinia Sunset RV Park. In combination, these properties comprise some 1,200 hectares of developed industrial land, and 46,000 square metres of commercial building space. In 2022, the Port took ownership also of the Argentinia harbour water lot comprising another 320 hectares.

Supported by ongoing infrastructure upgrades and expansion plans, the Port of Argentinia is poised to capture opportunities in support of key industry sectors, including renewable and ocean energy, aquaculture, and mining. Construction is underway establishing North America's first monopile marshalling yard at Argentinia, in support of US offshore wind; and, a proposed onshore wind development and hydrogen production facility to export green ammonia is being planned on site.

Port of Argentinia, is a private not-for-profit corporation mandated to provide effective stewardship of the seaport and industrial property at Argentinia, NL to enhance the region's economic vitality and quality of life. The Port is led by a dedicated volunteer board of directors, and a professional management team with knowledge in port and property management, marketing and promotion, and business and economic development.
